• Corrects structural deficiencies of buildings with a "poor" seismic rating. Also, deferred major maintenance (roof replacement, deck replacement, etc.) will be performed on buildings at the same time.

• Addresses seismic and life-safety deficiencies in select student-fee-funded facilities. Buildings considered for this project include the Student Music East-KZSC Radio Station, Merrill College Recreation Room (Cantu GLBTI Center), Student Union, Student Union Redwood Building, and Cardiff House Women's Center.

• Current and ongoing campus seismic/life safety fees will be used to pay the debt service on this project.

• Supports campus CFP objectives for Student Life/Intellectual Engagement and Residential Life; and Campus Environment, Sustainability, and Life Safety.
