

Campus Life Safety Improvements

- This project will address fire and life-safety improvements, critical primary and emergency power requirements, and improve storm-water-management system.
- Selected instruction and research buildings will be retrofitted with modern automatic sprinkler systems and modern, fully addressable fire-alarm systems.
- Capacity for primary and emergency power will be increased, along with upgrades and expansion of electrical distribution system and increased redundancy for the safety of the campus and critical research in the event of a major power outage.
- Obsolete non-compliant utility systems will be replaced, and storm-drain structural upgrades will comply with more stringent environmental regulations.
