

Davis Recreation Pool Renovation

Fiscal Year: 2014-15

Project Description

- Existing Center dates back to the late 1960s, and the age of the facility and the changing ways in which the UC Davis community utilizes aquatic amenities has resulted in the need to renovate. Equipment and pool systems have reached the end of their useful lives.
- Addresses code deficiencies, including access (ADA), diving board, and pool decking, and deficiencies at the bathhouse, and provides facilities to accommodate multiple types of recreational aquatics on one site.
- Renovates the Rec Pool facility, including developing multiple pools to provide space for recreational swimming and a "fitness" pool for lap swimming and possible sport club use (approx. 8,000 sf pool heated for year-round use; approx. 7,220 sf seasonal pool).
- Includes new pool operating systems, an outdoor pavilion to be repurposed from the existing bathhouse (approx. 3,350 sf), a new/renovated bathhouse, office, and entry area as well as other recreational components.
- Located on existing Rec Pool site, corner of La Rue Road and Hutchison Drive.
