FY of Approval: 2015-16

Project Description

- Improves fire and life safety in multiple campus locations.
- Installs fire alarm or fire sprinkler systems in high-risk buildings, including laboratory buildings and large assembly facilities.
- Replaces outdated and unreliable fire alarm systems in 10 buildings—including installation of modern pull stations, heat detectors, and audio-visual signal devices.
- Installs fire sprinkler systems in 2 physical sciences laboratory buildings that house large amounts of flammable, combustible liquids.
- Includes the installation of a potable water/fire suppression water line that will provide increased water pressure and additional water supply to the campus.
