THIS WEEK IN CONGRESS AND THE ADMINISTRATION

- This week, the Senate is in recess.
- On Monday, House Democrats are expected to vote on a [resolution](#) calling on Vice President Mike Pence to initiate the 25th Amendment process. Should Vice President Pence not move to invoke the 25th Amendment, the House is expected to vote on an article, drafted by Reps. Jaime Raskin (D-MD), David Cicilline (D-RI) and Ted Lieu (D-CA), impeaching President Trump with high crimes and misdemeanors for willfully inciting violence against the government.

- On Tuesday, the Senate Armed Services Committee will hold a hearing titled, "Civilian Control of the Armed Forces."
