2019 UC Women's Initiative for Professional Development (UC WI) Program Information and Nomination Process

UC WI is an experiential professional development program offered to mid-career women faculty, academic personnel and staff who demonstrate the potential to advance their careers at UC.

Purpose

To help women advance in their UC Careers and retain women who have demonstrated potential for advancement

Sponsors and Management

- UC WI is sponsored by the President's Office and the [Systemwide Advisory Committee on the Status of Women \(SACSW\)](#)
- Systemwide Talent Management (STM) administers the program and coordinates nominations with locations

Target Audience

- Mid-career faculty, academic personnel, and staff from campuses, health centers, Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, and Office of the President
- Women who have demonstrated potential for advancement

Program Overview

- Program fee of \$1,925 per participant
- Six regional cohorts (three North and three South), accommodating 180 participants
- Co-facilitated by Coro Northern California and UC WI Graduates
- Regional North and South final capstone events

Participant Outcomes

- Build strategic relationships
- Actively communicate their value to the organization
- Advocate for their own needs in the workplace
- Demonstrate their value to the organization by coaching others
- Increase awareness of diverse UC career paths

Participant Criteria

- Women in mid-career who demonstrate the potential to advance in their careers at UC
- Current faculty, academic personnel, and staff
- Represent the diversity at each UC location
- Represent different functions and departments at each location
- Able to commit to the program with full attendance and participation at all sessions
- Able to complete intersession assignments which require up to two hours between seminars
- Have commitment and support of their nominating sponsor and/or manager

Program Participation Expectations

- Participate fully and actively in all sessions
 - The program is experiential and relies heavily on full participant contribution
- Attend all sessions
 - Locations will not be refunded for participants who are unable to complete the program
- Complete Pre-Work and Pre-Program Survey before the first day of their assigned cohort
- Complete up to 2 hours of additional work assigned between program sessions

UC WI Participant Costs

- \$1,925 participant fee covers all program materials and facilitation fees
- The participant's UC location is responsible for covering all travel related costs

Nomination Process

The nomination process to fill all six 2019 cohorts opens September 7, 2018 and closes October 12, 2018. By nominating and selecting an individual, the location is agreeing to payment of the \$1,925 participant fee and participant travel expenses.

- Location Responsibilities
 - Manage and communicate own internal nomination process to coincide with the nomination timeline below
 - Locations may use the online UC WI Nomination Form or one of their own
 - Locations may include past UC WI graduates in the selection process
 - Determine final participants and alternates for all three 2019 cohorts (see location allocation chart below)
 - Submit final participant and prioritized alternate names to Systemwide Talent Management using the [online UC WI Nomination Form](#) by **October 24, 2018**
 - Communicate to selected participants and alternates by **October 29, 2018**
- Systemwide Talent Management Responsibilities
 - Provide online UC WI Nomination Form and link to all locations
 - Provide weekly Nomination Report to each location beginning September 14, 2018
 - Provide a final list of all selected participants to each location upon completion of the cohort placement process
 - Communicate to selected participants to request cohort preference and other program information
 - Notify participants of final cohort placement and manage follow-up communications throughout each cohort
 - Contact alternate participants to fill open spaces, as needed, per the priority indicated by each location
