- Celebrates collaboration
- Selected by the CIOs

Who gets awards?

- Projects not individuals
- From any UC location
- Submit as many applications / projects as you like
- One submission for large projects with many components

What makes an application stand out?

- Be succinct, use plain English, stay within the 5 page limit
- Include the requested information
- Highlight the collaboration / cross location teams / partnerships
- Emphasize the solution / impact, not the technology
- Describe the innovative spark
- Tell the story



How do the winners get selected?

- May 18, 2018, deadline
- Submit PDF or Word doc via email
- Selection committee meets in June/July
- Applicants informed a week later

- Presented each year at the UC Computing Services Conference
- UCD August 13 15, 2018 https://uccsc.ucdavis.edu/
- Up to 3 golden, 2 silver, 5 honorable mentions
- Plaque/certificate, announcements, prestige among peers
- Publicized in UC IT Blog and campus news
