

UC Employment Verification Services

Campus Impact

The impact of implementing employment and income verification services in the cloud has been tremendous. Since June 1, 2012, all verifications are being performed via The Work Number®, which is a free service provided by Equifax, resulting in significant cost savings and increased efficiency for the University of California, Riverside.

Business Need

Traditionally, numerous offices were involved in verifying employment and income each time an employee shopped for a new car, rented/leased an apartment, or engaged in the purchase or refinance of a home. This required almost constant time and attention from multiple offices, impacting everyone from the central offices (Accounting, Payroll, Human Resources) to the college, organization, and department offices across campus. By leveraging a free, cloud-based service for this purpose, these verifications can be performed independently, resulting in greater efficiency throughout all levels of the institution.

Features and Highlights

Effective June 1, 2012, this new employment verification service was made available to all UCR employees as part of our institution's "Working Smarter" initiative. The Work Number® is a secure automated service providing employees with the ability to quickly deliver proof of employment or income. Employees benefit from having control of the verification process by authorizing access to their information directly through The Work Number®, which provides verification services to two out of three Fortune 500 companies and 90% of federal agencies. It is widely known to mortgage lenders, banks, apartment complexes and others who may need proof of your employment or income. It is easy to use and is available anytime, anywhere, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

UCR employees have the ability to "opt out" of this service, if desired. A tool exists within UCR's portal environments for employees to indicate that their employment/income information should not be shared outside of UCR (see screen-shot below). Employees who have opted out are programmatically filtered out via SQL and are thereby excluded from files generated for and transmitted to The Work Number® system.

Security Certification

RWeb users must be aware of the following security precautions. Please thoroughly read each precaution carefully. You may then click on the checkbox to certify that you have read, understand, and agree to comply with the following 5 security precautions and employment verification items:

Security Precautions

Employment Verification

UCR uses The Work Number® to provide employment and income verification services. These types of services are used when applying for a credit card, car or other loans; or to rent/lease an apartment. If you are (or become) a UCR student employee, federal privacy rules (i.e. the Family Educational Rights Privacy Act) allow you to restrict release of your employment data. However, if this data is restricted, NO other mechanism is available to perform employment or income verifications. [See more](#)

In early 2015, UCR was contacted by the UCPATH Project Management Office and the UCPATH Center to discuss the possibility of leveraging UCR's infrastructure to benefit additional UC locations. UCR provided all code and shared the logic and instructions for querying necessary employee/job information in order to generate files for transmission to The Work Number®. As of this writing, two additional locations are using this technology (UCLA and UCSC), and there are plans to deploy to the entire UC system eventually.

The Process: Technology and Implementation

UC Riverside maintains a local Human Resources Data Warehouse (HRDW), which is an Oracle 11g database updated nightly via a feed of the Payroll Personnel System (PPS) database. The HRDW satisfies many campus needs, from transaction processing (e.g. time and attendance reporting, enterprise directory, employee profile system) to reporting and ad-hoc query capabilities. Moreover, the HRDW facilitates transmission of the necessary information to enable employment and income verifications via The Work Number®.

UCR analyzed the data elements required by The Work Number® and then “mapped” them to the local HR data warehouse. Query logic was then written in SQL and a PL/SQL stored procedure was developed to retrieve the necessary information and generate files in the format and record definition required by The Work Number®. A similar procedure was developed for generating the year-end file which provides year to date income information for all employees.

Technology Summary

- Oracle 11g database server
- PL/SQL stored procedures for ETL
- Secure file transmission to the cloud vendor (SFTP)
