¹ Transfer category includes second baccalaureate and limited status but excludes Education Abroad Program (EAP) students. Limited status are transfers who enroll for a fixed time and are not degree seeking students.

² The Universitywide SIR rate reflects the 'unduplicated' numbers – that is the rate of students admitted to the University who submitted a SIR to any UC campus. Because students can be admitted at more than one campus but only SIR to one campus, the Universitywide SIR rate can be higher than a SIR rate for each campus.

Note: Data include transfers who were offered admission to spring 2018 at Berkeley and winter 2018 at Santa Cruz.
