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#### Cover Letter and Statement of Consent

#### **Purpose**

The University of California Office of the President is conducting a cost of attendance survey for graduate students at every UC campus. The purpose of the study is to collect data to help University administrators better understand the actual cost of attending the University when formulating graduate funding packages and services. In addition, the results will inform current and prospective graduate students about the cost of attending UC.

#### **Procedure**

This feedback helps the University evaluate and improve graduate funding packages and services.

#### **Protecting Your Privacy**

Your personal information, limited to your name and email address, is used strictly for sending survey invitation and reminder messages. Such information is only accessible by survey administration staff.

After the survey is closed, your name and email address will be deleted from all survey datasets. Your student ID will be used to match survey responses against other data such as, but not limited to, your demographics, enrollment records, graduation data, applicant data, and post-baccalaureate data. This data is used for analysis and reporting.

Please be assured that your responses will be kept confidential and the results of the study will be reported only as aggregate (group level) data. Any identifiable information that is obtained in connection with this study will remain confidential. When this information is stored on third party secure platforms and secure file transfer suppliers, confidentiality will be maintained and your privacy protected according to the University of California privacy and security policies. This information will only be disclosed when required by law. All data used in public reporting will be reviewed to ensure that your identity cannot be ascertained. 
