Introduction

The University of California, a national leader in sustainability, launched the Carbon Neutrality Initiative (CNI) in 2013 with an aim of emitting net zero greenhouse gases from its activities, buildings, and vehicle fleets by 2025. 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Farmers Market Tabling

Throughout the Fall and Spring Quarter, CNI student engagement fellows tabled in the center of campus at the farmers market. We encouraged students to get involved with the Office of Sustainability, sign up for the sustainability newsletter, participate in the reusable utensil survey, and partake in the Aggie Green Pledge, designed to encourage individual lifestyle shifts.

UCD x UCDH Earth Week

To reach our goal of bridging the UCD main campus and the UCD health campus we worked to host intercampus Earth week events. We worked to organize a seed planting event for the UCDH campus, a virtual movie night, and celebrated Earth Day with a UCD and UCDH tree planting event hosted in collaboration with the Sacramento Tree Foundation. We planted 4 oak trees and distributed UCD Arboretum and Public Garden seed packets.

UCD Sustainability Summit

The UCD Sustainability Summit is an annual event that highlights the contributions and commitment of the campus, faculty, staff, and students in advancing sustainability and equity. We revamped the sustainability summit by introducing a guest speaker component. We are proud to he hosting Leah Thomas, founder of Intersectional Environmentalism and author of The Intersectional Environmentalist at our 2022 summit. Leah's presence is part of our larger commitment to advancing social justice.
