### 2011-12 Statewide Energy Partnership (SEP) Program

This report is submitted by the University of California in response to language contained in the 2012 Budget Act, which states:

"2. No later than November 15 of each year, the university shall prepare a report describing the identified projects funded under the Energy Partnership Program in the prior year. The report shall include the cost of each project, how the cost is being funded, including the amount funded from support budget funds and invest-or-owned utility incentive awards, and the projected amount of energy savings. These reports will sunset at the end of the program."

Provision 2 of Item 6440-0001 of the 2009 Budget Act (Chapter 1, Statutes of 2009, Fourth Extraordinary Session) permits the University of California to expend State operations funding for capital expenditures and debt service payment for projects associated with the university's 2010-12 Statewide Energy Partnership Program (Partnership Program) following legislative notification. This provision permits the University of California to update the list of approved energy efficiency projects as new projects are identified for inclusion in the program, consistent with the reporting requirements set forth in subdivision (e) of Section 28.00.

The following list identifies energy efficiency projects in State-supported facilities that have been completed in the third Fiscal Year of the Partnership Program, FY 11-12. However, the Partnership Program is based on a calendar year. Project completion is skewed toward the latter part of the 09-12 Program Cycle (July-December 2012). A project is only considered complete if a utility has signed off on the project, verifying the energy savings delivered by the project, and the University has received the approved incentive payment. Listed projects were undertaken in facilities eligible for State support, and it is anticipated that campuses will use State operating funds to cover project costs, including debt service.

We anticipate that when all the results for the 09-11 Program cycle are tallied, annual energy savings in State-funded buildings will total over \$14M. Overall the program will have avoided over \$21M in annual energy costs, meeting stated program goals. When Program results have been finalized, we will submit a final report of completed projects up to December 31, 2012, with totals for energy savings, investor owned utility awards, project cost and the University's share of these costs.
