Dear Senator Skinner, Assembly Member Ting, and Director Stephenshaw:

This letter conveys the certifications for all University of California entities with buildings subject to California Education Code section 92493 et seq. effective from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. Certifications for prior periods were addressed in submissions made in calendar year 2021. In this certification period, there were 241 buildings subject to the code, whereas 242 buildings were previously reported. This change reflects clarification of a funding source and funding eligibility and is not an oversight.

As was seen in prior submissions, the attached certifications include certain instances where work traditionally performed by persons with University of California Service Unit job classifications were performed by contract workers. In this certification cycle, there are significantly fewer of these instances reflecting the University's ongoing commitment to use AFSCME-represented University employees to perform service work consistent with Regents Policy 5402 and Article 5 of the AFSCME Collective Bargaining Agreement. The contracts present in the certifications are predominantly of a temporary or one-time nature and typically due to staff unavailability. In a few cases, the contracts were necessary because they were of a specialized nature, or due to COVID-19 staffing challenges that are unique to current circumstances directly impacted by the pandemic.

Wherever possible the University continues our best efforts to employ AFSCME service workers in meeting our complex operational needs. Given the ongoing staffing challenges that employers in California and nationwide continue to face, the University deals with difficulties recruiting and retaining employees in many AFSCME bargaining unit classifications. Thus, meeting our obligations under both SB 820 and Article 5 of the AFSCME collective bargaining agreements remains a significant challenge. As one

example, it is not generally feasible to recruit and retain employees for one-day or one-week projects on a sporadic or emergency basis. Thus, the University is forced to rely on contingent labor to meet its operational needs that include serving students, conducting research, treating patients, and otherwise fulfilling the mission of the University of California. However, as you will see from our certifications, the overwhelming majority of those services are performed by AFSCME bargaining unit employees, and the University has been able to reduce its reliance on contract labor as part of its commitment to use University employees whenever feasible.
