
Request to Serve as Principal Investigator By Exception

Per RPAC Contracts & Grants Manual <u>Chapter 1-530</u>, the following individuals automatically qualify to serve as Principal Investigator for a research, training or public service project:

- (a) Members of the Academic Senate, including emeriti;
- (b) Appointees in the Agronomist series, including emeriti; and
- (c) Appointees at 50 percent or more of full time in the Adjunct Professor series; Health Sciences Clinical Professor series; Professional Research series; and/or Specialists in Cooperative Extension series

All other University employees seeking to serve as a Principal Investigator must complete the following form and receive the requisite approvals:
