## When & Where

## What's OK to Bring

Hazardous wastes generated in the course of living in and maintaining your place of residence. Common household hazardous wastes are listed below. Wastes generated in the course of operating a business at a residence do not qualify.

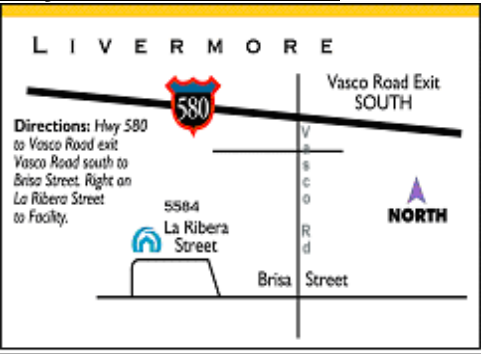
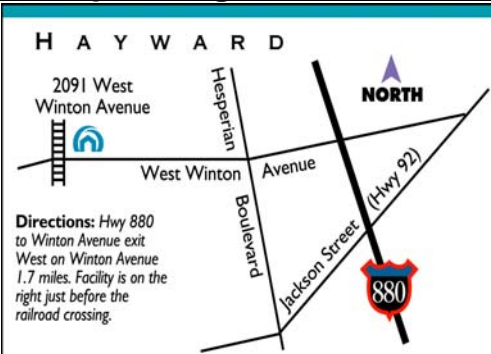
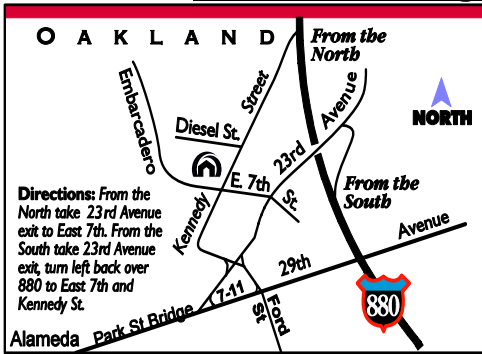
## How to Package

All materials must be packaged in sturdy, non-leaking, closed containers. **No individual container may be greater than 5 gallons or 50 pounds in size.** If you have a leaking container, place it in a larger, non-leaking container (such as a plastic bucket available from paint stores); include the original label or a note with as much information as possible about the material and its ingredients. **Do not mix different wastes in the same container.** Place the materials upright in your vehicle; for safety, we recommend placing materials in boxes in your vehicle's trunk. Pack the materials so they will not slide, tip over, spill or break during transport. Please drive carefully! **Once you are at our facilities, our staff will unload your wastes.** At your request, we will save your motor oil and gasoline cans. Label them with your name and phone number; they must be picked up on the same day after 3:00 p.m.

## How Much

**State law limits the total amount you may transport in one vehicle to 125 pounds or 15 gallons. Wastes must be transported by a resident of the household which generated the waste.**

**Oakland Facility                      2100 East 7th Street, Oakland**

Interstate 880 to 23rd Avenue exit. The facility is on the Corner of East 7th and Kennedy Streets west of the 880 freeway. The entrance is on East 7th Street. The Con Agra Grain towers, across East 7th Street from the facility, are visible from several blocks away. The facility is found in the Thomas Guide on page 670, section A1.

**Hayward Facility                      2091 West Winton Avenue, Hayward**

Interstate 880 to Winton Avenue exit. From the freeway, the facility is past the airport, the marine barracks and on the right hand side of Winton Avenue just before the railroad tracks. The facility is found in the Thomas Guide on page 711, section D4.

**Livermore Facility                      5584 La Ribera Street, Livermore**

Interstate 580 to Vasco Road exit. From the freeway, go south on Vasco Road to Brisa Street, turn right on Brisa Street and right again on La Ribera Street. The facility is found in the Thomas Guide on page 696, section D5.
