A. Climate and Energy

- UC Merced received a Resolution from the California State Legislature, written by California Senate Majority Leader Robert Hertzberg and Senator Anna Caballero, on UC Merced's Carbon Neutrality achievement.
- Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory received three recognitions for work on projects from the U.S. Department of Energy. LBNL's ISO 50001 team and building commissioning team were recognized for its approach to energy and water all facilities and activities, and both received a 2021 U.S. DOE Sustainability Award. The NERSC Efficiency Optimization Team was recognized with a 2020 U.S. DOE Sustainability Award.

B. Food

- UC Merced received 4 recognitions for its work with food. This includes the Outstanding Edible Food Recovery Program Award from the California Resource Recovery Association (CRRA) for its off campus food recovery and California Higher Education Awards in categories for Partnerships, Communications, & Planning: Cooking Up New Programs to "Leave No Food Behind" and Sustainable Food Service: "Ugly Produce" Rescue and Donation Initiative. Merced was also a finalist for the AASHE Campus Sustainability Achievement Award for "No Food Left Behind: A free text service to reduce food insecurity and food waste".
- UC Davis Health received a <u>Good Food 100</u> recognition from the Good Food Media Network to recognize its contribution to building better food systems.

C. Green Buildings and Operations

- UCLA received the <u>USGBC-LA Green Building Project of the year</u> for the UCLA Margo Leavin Graduate Art Studios.
- UC Merced was selected for the 2021 USGBC Leadership Award for the Pacific Region.
- UC Merced also received \$1.7 million for the <u>Saving by Design program</u> from PG&E.
- UC Merced received a California Higher Education Award in Interdisciplinary Academics for the Carson House Sustainable Futures project teaching students about sustainability in a community learning environment.
